Course Description

This course introduces students to mass appraisal and is a prerequisite for the IAAO 300-level course series. Topics covered include single-property appraisal as it compares to mass appraisal, components of a mass appraisal system, data requirements and analysis, introduction to statistics, use of assessment ratio studies in mass appraisal, modeling of the three approaches to value, and selection of a mass appraisal system.

Student Expectations

This course includes 30 hours of classroom instruction during which students will be expected to participate in discussions, group activities, and coursework that may include but is not limited to reading, homework problem solving, etc. both during and outside classroom hours. There is also an exam at the end of the course for which the student should be prepared.

Education Credit

Successful completion of this course provides 30 hours toward certification/continuing education for Class I assessors (N.D.C.C. 57-02-01.1). Twenty-seven hours are allowed as continuing education for attending the course if the exam is not taken. In order to receive credit for certification purposes, the exam must be successfully completed.
